## Key Knowledge

1	Samuel Crompton was born in Bolton on 3 <sup>rd</sup> December 1753. He died on 26 <sup>th</sup> June 1827.
2	He was an English inventor and pioneer of the spinning industry.
3	Building on the work of James Hargreaves and Richard Arkwright he invented the Spinning Mule.
4	At the time, he got no royalties for his invention and didn't receive the credit he deserved.
5	Crompton didn't get a patent for his machine, meaning others could use his ideas for free.
6	He invented his Spinning Mule in his Hall I' Th' Wood house.
