- 1) Florence Nightingale **was born on 12th May 1820.**
- 2) Florence Nightingale **became a nurse in 1851.**
- 3) The Crimean War **started in 1853 and ended in 1856.**
- 4) **Florence Nightingale helped improve the conditions in hospitals and became known as the 'lady with the lamp'.**
- 5) **Florence Nightingale died on 13th August 1910.**

Lady of the Lamp	A name given to Florence Nightingale by wounded soldiers in the Crimean War because she carried a lamp with her as she walked around the hospital	Scutari	A location where a British Army hospital was and where Florence Nightingale worked during the Crimean war in Turkey
Notes on Nursing	A book first published by Florence Nightingale in 1859	Crimean War	A military conflict between 1853 and 1856
