

CLASSROOM NEWS

This term in Reception, we will be learning about:

Reading – Continuing to learn how to read letter sounds and putting sounds together to read words and sentences. To read words that cannot be sounded out e.g. the, we, my.

Writing – Using our letter sounds to write words and sentences. Remembering to use finger spaces when writing and a full stop at the end of our sentences. To be able to read back what we have written. To form all of our letters correctly so they can be read by others.

Maths – Count and understand numbers beyond 10. Adding, taking away, sharing and doubling. Recognising odd and even numbers. Matching, rotating and manipulating shapes.

RE – Special places.

Exploring places that are special to us and to different religions including Christians and Muslims.

Topic 1 -

Down in the Garden – learning about what plants need to grow.

Bugs and minibeasts - exploring the bugs and minibeasts in our own environment.

Topic 2 -

We are all Heroes – To explore what qualities make a superhero and learn about some real life superheroes.
