RE topics

We will be thinking about:
Eid and Stories that Jesus told

This term we will be reading stories that will develop our interests in different animals as well as continuing to develop positive attitudes about the differences between people and understanding the key features of the life cycle of an animal.

If your child is in school please remember to bring a water bottle everyday and some wellies to keep in school so your child can play out in the sand pit and on the grass. PE is on Tuesday, please make sure children have suitable clothing and footwear.

Stories and experiences to develop children's curiosity of the world we live in.

We have had eggs delivered from Smithills farm so hopefully children will be able to see and understand the life cycle of a chick. We will be visiting Smithills farm for our end of year trip so that's why we have chosen books about different animals as well as getting a range of non-fiction books from the library loan service. A lot of the books contain 'rhyme' as we want to develop their phonological awareness so that they can spot and suggest rhymes as well as developing their phonological awareness so that they can recognise words with the same initial sound. We also want the children to know that there are different countries in the world and talk about differences they have experienced or seen in photos.

Nursery Rhymes

We are still singing nursery rhymes everyday and will be using percussion instruments to tap out beats to the rhymes. Nursery rhymes are so important and being able to sing a selection of them will really help your child with the first stages of reading by themselves.

Maths

We are continuing to use the Numberblock episodes from Cbeebies to think about numbers. We have met the characters 1,2,3,4,5 and now know what they look like. Children will now be subitising numbers 1 to 5 and looking at the composition of numbers 1 to 5 as well as addition and subtraction of numbers to 5.
