





Homework in Reception.

Our 2 topic areas for this term are:
Dinosaurs

In this topic we will be learning about the history of dinosaurs, how we find out about them, the different types of dinosaurs, their habitats in comparison with where we live alongside looking at the features of stories and rhymes.

Superheroes


In this topic we are going to be looking at fictional superheroes and real life superheroes in our society. We will be looking at the different roles of heroes, the use of our imaginations and creativity when retelling stories, comparing different environments and again the features of stories and rhymes.

Please remember to send your child to school, in their PE kit every Wednesday. This should be navy shorts/ leggings/ jogging bottoms, white t-shirt and a navy jumper or cardigan and either black pumps or during the colder weather trainers

Alongside these 2 topic areas we will also be doing some work around :

Chinese New Year—This year 2022 is the year of the Tiger. We will be talking about the history of the festival and how it is celebrated.

The Christian festival of Easter—We will be talking about how important Easter is to Christians and why and how it is celebrated.



Maths

Our maths areas of learning this term are:

Alive in 5—in this area we are looking at the number 5 in detail, comparing numbers to 5 and the composition of 5.

Growing 6,7 and 8— making pairs and combining 2 groups

Building 9 and 10—comparing numbers to 10 and learning about number bonds to 10.

We will also be learning about weight, capacity, length, height, shape and pattern throughout the term.

English and reading

Please make sure that you are reading and practising sounds with your child as much as possible at home. This really is very important and has a great impact on your child's progress.

Please encourage your child to practise writing their name and words using the sounds they know. Make sure that they are forming each letter correctly.
