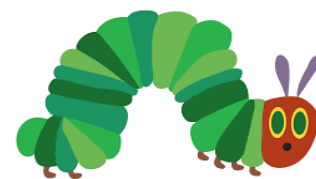




Nursery

Physical Development

Please help your child at home by practising how to put their own coat and shoes on and take them off again. See if your child can zip up their own coat.

When your child is writing, please encourage them to use the correct pencil grip. If you are unsure, please ask a member of the Nursery staff.

Please help your child by encouraging them to practise writing their name at home. Please see Nursery staff if you are unsure of how to form the cursive letters in your child's name.

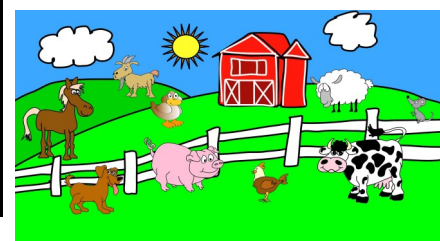
Maths

Help your child at home by counting up to 20 and singing counting rhymes such as 'one, two, three, four, five, once I caught a fish alive' and 'five little ducks went swimming one day'. See if they can recognise numbers when you go out. Talk about sizes and shapes of things with your child and use language such as big, small, round and tall.

How to help your child at home

Topic 1 Go on bug hunts with your child and talk about what you find and how to look after the creatures. Talk about all the different animals that you see when you are out.

Topic 2 Look on the internet to find pictures and information about pirates. Talk about how we can find information on computers.



Our Topics this term are:
