PE Kits

Just a reminder that children are allowed to wear their PE kit to school on PE days. PE kit should include a white t-shirt, navy shorts and black pumps. We are happy for children to wear trainers instead of pumps, especially as the weather is wetter and colder at the moment. We are also happy for children to wear either jogging bottoms or leggings (instead of shorts) to keep warm and dry for a day in school. Reminders

Parking: Please be mindful when you are bringing your child to school in a vehicle. Please do not park on the yellow zig zag lines or drop off right outside the school gates— it can be very dangerous. Please help us to ensure that our children are able to get to and from school safely. Can we also ask that you are considerate of our neighbours when parking. If people continue to park inappropriately around school then we may have to ask the council to send the traffic cameras to monitor this.

Face coverings: Please wear a face covering when dropping off and collecting your child from school.

Money into school: We are trying to minimise the number of adults on the school site therefore please do not go to the office to make payments. If you need to send money into school for dinners, snacks, trips, breakfast club, nursery fees etc. this should be sent into school in an envelope clearly marked with your child's full name, class and what the money is for and handed in to your child's class teacher. Can we remind you that dinner money is £9.00 a week to be paid on a Monday. Snacks are £1.65 a week to be paid on a Friday for the following week and breakfast club is £5.00 a week to be paid on a Friday for the following week.
