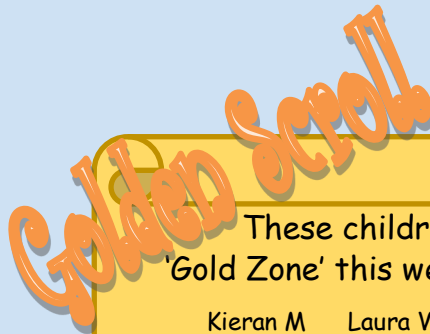
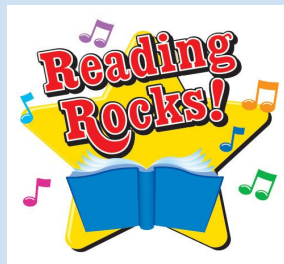


Reading Awards
