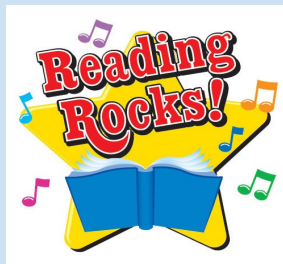


# Reading Awards
