Reminders

Uniform and PE kits: Please can you label all items of your child's uniform including PE kits, coats and shoes. This enables staff to return any mislaid items to your child.

Money into school: Any money sent into school for dinners, snacks, trips, breakfast club, nursery fees etc. should be sent in an envelope clearly marked with your child's name, class and what the money is for and handed in to your child's class teacher or the school office. Can we remind you that dinner money is £8.50 a week to be paid on a Monday. Snacks are £1.60 a week to be paid on a Friday for the following week and breakfast club is £5.00 a week to be paid on a Friday for the following week.
