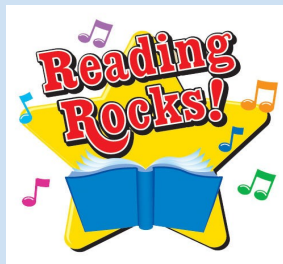


Reading Awards
