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Dear Parents/Carers of children in Class 5,

Whilst your child is self-isolating at home, it is our responsibility to organise home learning for your child to complete whilst they are absent from school. As the period of self-isolation is 14 days; we are providing enough home learning opportunities to last up until 25.09.20.

We are currently offering two ways of working for your child - either through the use of a paper based work pack or through the online platform 'SeeSaw'. The log in details your child will need for 'SeeSaw' and the paper based packs can be collected from the school office. You are more than welcome to use both ways of working; whichever suits you and your child's needs.

With any work that is set, either on paper or online, the expectation is that your child will complete all the work. Mrs Parkinson will be setting daily and weekly activities on 'SeeSaw' that your child can complete and return to her.

Daily online tasks will include: English, maths, reading/phonics and times tables

Weekly online tasks may include: R.E, topic (history/geography), science, PSHCE, music, P.E, art, D.T

Mrs Parkinson will stick to the normal daily/weekly timetable for her class as much as possible.

All work completed online on 'SeeSaw' will be acknowledged by the class teacher or by the teaching assistant in the class on a daily and weekly basis. All online work will be marked with either a 'like' or with audio or written feedback. Paper based work packs that are completed must be returned to school after the isolation period for the class teacher to acknowledge and mark. Please ensure we can move your child's learning on as soon as they return to school by completing the work that is given/set.

School will contact you during the isolation period to check how home learning is going and to see if you need any further support.
